



Issachar Apprenticeship Info 2018

The Issachar Apprenticeship is a two-year Urban Christian Leadership program which takes a diverse group of college students through a rigorous program of academics, servant-leadership, and discipleship.

We are looking for:

- Students who will be studying at a college, grad school, or trade school in the fall of 2018.
- Diverse students - we want to have a mix of cultural backgrounds, including white students.
- Students who have shown an ability to pass college classes.
- Students who have some leadership experience and want to invest in at-risk communities.
- Students who are passionate about Urban Christian Leadership and willing to commit to being part of a leadership training community.
- Students who commit to being pushed to go beyond their perspectives and experience.

The program is made up of 5 Components:

- **Academics:** All Issachar students attend college. We provide tutoring, coaching and a \$6,000/year tuition-assisted scholarship for up to 4 years, helping students develop the life and study skills necessary for graduation and beyond.
- **Residential Cohort:** All apprentices live for 2 years in a 6-unit residential facility, learning to manage household responsibilities, pay rent, and live with others.
- **Leading from Below:** Apprentices study public leadership, community engagement, and urban issues during dinner and training one night each week. Guests and partners regularly join us.
- **Leading from Within:** Apprentices go through a spiritual formation program during an extended morning gathering once a week.
- **Community/Vocational Service:** All apprentices continue to apply their learning and explore their calling while serving with local organizations 6-8 hours a week.

In total, students' responsibilities require about 60 hours a week. Students receive a monthly stipend in order to give priority to these responsibilities.
